What's the weather like in New Hampshire?

Average temperatures in the White Mountains in the summer is 75 (24 C) – 85 (29 C) degrees. The average low is in the 50s (10 C) – it can get chilly some nights! Please also make sure you pack a rain jacket - there are some rainy days here and there.

Does CWW have a dress code? What do I wear?

You will get 2 CWW staff T-shirts to be worn on weekends, but we do not require you to wear a staff t-shirt every day. Day – to –Day camp attire is comfortable athletic wear. Please ensure you bring proper swim attire. One-piece swimsuit for females and swim trunks/board shorts for males.

Can I bring my cellphone, computer, or Ipad to camp?

Absolutely! There is wifi in CK. Just remember that you cannot use your technology around the campers or at any time unless it is your period off. But, if we're being honest, most people really enjoy disconnecting for the summer and being present in the day-to-day awesomeness of camp!

When do staff depart camp?

The last day of camp is Sunday, August 9th, and your commitment to camp will end at 12 noon. Please do not make air or bus travel arrangements home from Boston before 3:00 pm.

What kind of bedding do I need?

If you are traveling from outside the U.S. or Canada – we will provide bedding for you. If you live in the U.S. or Canada, you must supply your own bedding. Neither campers nor counselors are permitted to use a sleeping bag in their cabin. You will need a pillow, pillowcase, cot sheets (or twin size), blankets, bath & beach towels.

It may be more convenient purchasing it on Amazon or Walmart and having it sent to camp before your arrival. This is usually cheaper than shipping it.

Can someone visit me at camp?

We ask that if you live nearby or your friends and family want to visit you on a day off, you let us know ahead of time. We generally do not allow visitors. We ask that you reach out to us before making any plans to have people visit camp.

What does time Off look like?

You will have at least one period off each day (about one hour). You will have 2-3 nights off each week, from when your cabin responsibilities end until 1 am. You will have 2 half days off during orientation and 5 full days (26 hours) during the weeks with campers.

When do I arrive at camp?

The start date listed on your contract is your arrival date. For the majority of you, you will arrive on June 6th, June 11th, or June 17th. If you are uncertain or still have questions, please reach out for more clarification!
